

phoebe application guide

Choosing the correct Phoebe monitor arm requires consideration of a number of factors.

1. Does the desk have a rear privacy screen.
2. Type and thickness of mounting surface
3. Is the desk edge or through desk fitment required

If the desk has a rear privacy screen or is positioned against a wall it is recommended to fit two single monitor arms as opposed to one double, in order to achieve a full range of positions (see Fig.A).

When the desk has a privacy screen and you are using two single monitor arms clamped at the correct distance apart, then the monitors can be adjusted into a wide variety of positions. With the screens either flat or slightly angled they can be pushed all the way to the back or brought as far forward as required. They are also able to rotate round to one side of the desk without having to adjust the position of the clamps.

If however a Phoebe Duo is used with typical widescreen monitors, a desk privacy screen would restrict the positioning of the monitors as shown in Fig.B. Therefore when specifying Phoebe double monitor arms it is important to check that there is enough space behind the clamping point to manoeuvre the arms if the displays are required to have a full range of back to front adjustment.
